Each year, the Skoll Centre for Social Entrepreneurship awards five full scholarships to individuals who wish to enter the one year full-time Oxford MBA programme.

To qualify, you need a proven track record in social entrepreneurship and a clear vision for the impact the MBA can make to society.

The Scholarship covers fees and a stipend for living costs. The application fee can be waived for candidates from developing economies.
